

1. Kyoto Foreign Student House

- This reinforced concrete 3 storey building with basement was constructed in 1980 and after a seismic tolerance survey in September 2011, underwent renovations to improve earthquake resistance.
- The first floor is a lounge, the second floor has 18 men's rooms and the third floor has 20 women's rooms.
- A communal kitchen, laundry room, restroom, and shower room are located on each of the two upper floors. Washing machines and showers are coin operated. Bicycle parking is provided.

3. Room Information, Minimum and Maximum Residence Periods and Charges

□ Rooms: The available individual rooms are approximately 2.73 x 2.73 meters (7 m²) in size. They come with a futon bedding closet, clothing closet, shoe storage shelf, shelf, chair, air conditioner (cooler/heater), light fixtures, curtains, bed frame and mattress.

□ <u>Length of Stay</u>: Students can stay for a minimum of one semester and not longer than 4 'semesters. As a general rule, extensions are not permitted.)
