### TOEIC Test for the General (I) and other Entrance Examinations

The Kyoto Institute of Technology Graduate School of Science and Technology Master's Program General Entrance Examination (I), the Special Entrance Examination for Adults (Fall Admission) and the Special Entrance Examination for International Students (Fall Admission) will take place on August 19 (Thu) and August 20 (Fri), 2021. At the time of application, the submission of the original TOEIC® Listening & Reading Official Score Certificate (hereinafter the Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate) is required for any major except the Advanced Fibro-Science. Due to this fact, as per our communication dated March 23, applicants who do not have an Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate (issued within 2 years from the final day of the application period) should apply for one of the TOEIC Tests (the 268<sup>th</sup> or the 269<sup>th</sup> TOEIC Test), to be held on May 23 (Sun). (For each major's requirements regarding the Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate, please refer to the communication dated December 18, 2020).

However, it was later found out that there were some prospective test takers who had not been selected through the random selection process for the 268<sup>th</sup> and the 269<sup>th</sup> TOEIC Test; therefore, we have decided to exceptionally recognize the Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate of the 270<sup>th</sup> and the 271<sup>st</sup> TOEIC Test, to be held on June 20th (Sun). Those who wish to apply should follow the steps below and complete the necessary procedures.

#### 【TOEIC Application】

Those who wish to make use of this special measure, should apply for one of the TOEIC® Listening & Reading Tests (the 270<sup>th</sup> or the 271<sup>st</sup> TOEIC Test) within the following application period.

270<sup>th</sup> (June 20 (Sun) A.M.): 12:00 on Thu, April 22 to 15:00 on Mon., April 26

271<sup>st</sup> (June 20 (Sun) P.M.): 12:00 on Thu, May 6 to 15:00 on Mon., May 10

Note: Be sure to select the "Score Display Service" when you apply for the test.

#### 【Application Documents】

Please complete the following procedures ① through ③:

- ① If you have taken the 270<sup>th</sup> or the 271<sup>st</sup> TOEIC Test, please submit a copy of the TOEIC Test Admission Ticket when you apply for the General Entrance Examination (I), the Special Entrance Examination for Adults (Fall Admission) and the Special Entrance Examination for

International Students (Fall Admission).

Applicants who already have a valid TOEIC score should also submit the Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate.

- ② The scores of the 270<sup>th</sup> and the 271<sup>st</sup> TOEIC Tests will be available online on July 7 (Wed); please submit the score by July 13 (Tue), using one of the two following methods.
  - (1) Print out the score and submit it to the Admissions Office.
  - (2) Send the score as a PDF file by e-mail to the inquiries address below.
  
- ③ Submit the Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate to the Admissions Office by July 28 (Wed) using one of the two following methods.
  - (1) Bring the original Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate to the Admissions Office (by 16:00 on July 28).
  - (2) Post the original Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate to the inquiries address below (must be postmarked by July 28).

Note: If you submit an Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate at the time of application, that score will be compared with the score of the 270<sup>th</sup>/271<sup>st</sup> TOEIC Test and the higher score will be used.

However, if you have not submitted the Individual TOEIC Official Score Certificate of the 270<sup>th</sup> /271<sup>st</sup> TOEIC Test by July 28, then the score submitted at the time of application will be used.

**【In case you are not selected for the 270<sup>th</sup> and the 271<sup>st</sup> TOEIC Test】**

Applicants who applied for the 270<sup>th</sup> or the 271<sup>st</sup> TOEIC Test and were not selected through the random selection process, should inform us by email at the following address by May 31 (Mon).
